Be Your Own Training Video and e-Learning Voice Over Artist

January 13, 2015 | 11:30 - 1:00 pm Bethel University, 5885 Ridgeway Circle Registration: astdmemphis.org



Your course looks fantastic, but how does it sound? Learning is most effective when it takes advantage of both audio and visual pathways into the brain. Adding quality voiceovers

to your course video or eLearning program can greatly enhance knowledge transfer. But hiring professional voiceover talent can be expensive, and subject-matter experts may not always be available. That leaves just one person: you!

In this interactive and engaging session, you will learn what to do once you receive a script for your training product. You will receive a small portion of a script on which to practice mark-up techniques. You will make minor modifications to the script to make it as natural as possible to read. You will also

learn which words or phrases to emphasize to match the instructional content, and to clarify any issues with the SME or content provider. You will explore four simple audio editing techniques for reducing background noise, improving the quality of the narration, removing unwanted portions of the audio, and optimizing the audio for playback. You will also learn how to set up an inexpensive recording studio to further improve the quality of voiceovers.

In this session, you will learn:

- How to review, prepare, and modify a voiceover script to ensure narration quality while maintaining instructional integrity
- Techniques you can immediately use to sound your best during the recording phase
- Four easy steps to enhance the quality of your narration and remove unwanted sounds and noise with audio editing software
- How to optimize your audio for playback and make post-production changes
- How to create a very inexpensive recording studio

About the Speaker

Charles (Chuck) Jones is an award-winning instructional designer, eLearning developer, and consultant. Since 1998, he has designed and developed many interactive facilitator-led and technology-assisted learning and performance support tools for a large government agency. He is a three-time recipient of the Memphis Federal Executive Board's Outstanding Project Manager of the Year Award. Chuck holds a master's degree in education with a specialization in adult distance learning. He currently serves as President-Elect for ATD Memphis.



News from ATD Memphis

2014 Membership Satisfaction **Survey Results**

The survey was launched on November 19, 2014, and was closed on December 10, 2014.

DEMOGRAPHICS

- 64% participants have been Chapter members less than 5 years, and 44% are ASTD National and Local members.
- 67% have been in the training field for more than 10 years.
- Top highest training expertise is instructional design (62%), management training (59%), and career development (41%).
- Level of education PhDs (22%), Masters (50%), Bachelor's (20%), and others (8%)

COMMUNICATIONS

- 95% received emails, and 72% are very satisfied and satisfied with the emails
- Email was ranked top preferred method for receiving regular communications.

WEBSITE

- 54% members visited 1-5 times during the last six months.
- 59% members have not updated their profile in the "Members-Only" section.
- 66% participants are very satisfied and satisfied with the website.

PROGRAM TOPICS

The top highest themes were Coaching (53%), e-Learning (53%), Mobile Learning (53%), Career Development (50%), and Change management (47%).

CHAPTER MEETINGS

- 72% participants have attended once, twice and/or three times in the past three months
- 62% participants did not participate in the ALPS (Day of Learning) in November 2013.




